Attention CSCA families,

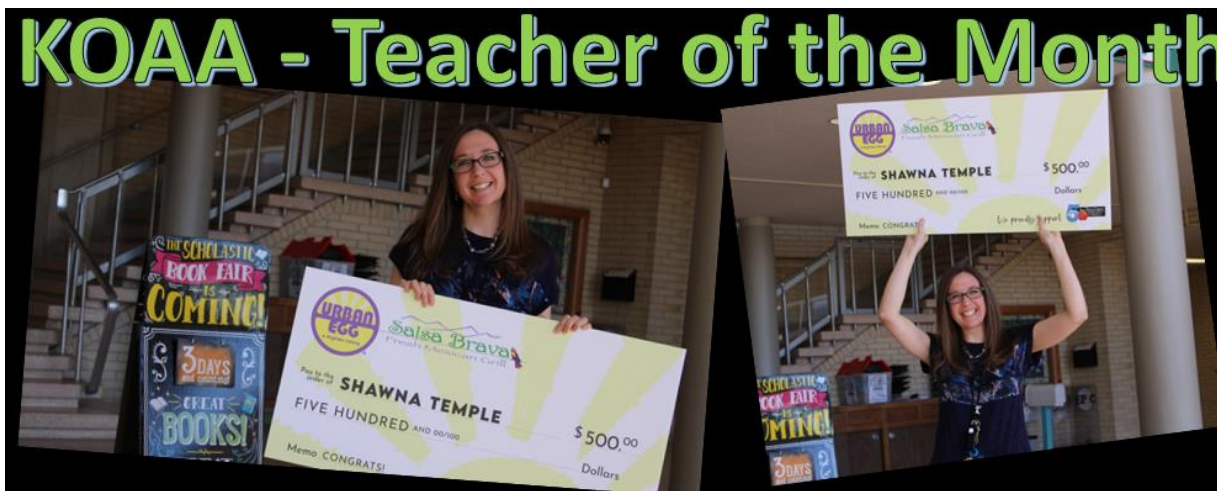
